## OCP PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Collect specimens prior to taking antibiotics or anti-diarrhea agents.
- 2. Avoid the use of antacids, barium, bismuth, or laxatives prior to collection.
- 3. If possible, specimen collections should be spaced one day apart.

## **SPECIMEN COLLECTION**

- 1. The specimen should be collected directly into the collection cup provided.
- 2. Using the spoon attached to the cap of each specimen transport /preservative vial, place an amount of stool sufficient to bring the volume of contents in each transport/preservative vial to the red line marked on the label. Stool should be added to a pink-top and a blue-top vial for each specimen collected.
- 3. Tighten the caps and shake vigorously to ensure the specimen is adequately mixed.
- 4. Label each vial with first and last name, date of birth, date and time. Hold vials at room temperature until all collections have been accomplished.
- 5. When all collections have been accomplished, transport the transport / preservative vials to the laboratory.
