Outcomes for Outpatient Physical Therapy

Program outcomes are monitored through an internal tracking system and include the following data for January – December 2017. Total number of patients treated by physical therapy was 6714. The percent of patients who completed treatment = 75%. The average number of treatment sessions for all diagnoses was 8. 100% of patients with all diagnoses who completed a satisfaction survey responded that the overall program services provided were either excellent or satisfactory.

Outcomes for Outpatient Occupational and Speech Therapy

Program outcomes are monitored through an internal tracking system and include the following data for January – December 2017. Total number of occupational therapy patients treated was 1329 and speech therapy patients treated was 626. The percent of patients who completed treatment = 81% for occupational therapy and 95% for speech therapy. The average number of treatment sessions for all occupational therapy diagnoses was 8 and for speech therapy was 3. 100% of patients with all diagnoses who completed a satisfaction survey responded that the overall program services provided were either excellent or satisfactory.
